# Camp Equipment List

Wiradjuri Language & Culture camp will be held 26-28 November. In order for camp activities to run smoothly, it is essential that all students pack the following equipment. Please remember though that we are only going for 2 days and 2 nights so don't pack too much. BUT don't pack too little.

The following list is the minimum equipment required for camp. **Please ensure you are well organised and have all of the required equipment.**

**Clothing for all activities-** Students will be required to wear appropriate shoes, clothing and sun protection to be able to participate in all activities. Open footwear (eg. sandals), midriff tops, singlet tops, skirts and jewellery are **not** appropriate for the camp program.

**PLEASE CLEARLY NAME ALL ITEMS.**

It is a good idea for students to pack their own bags so that they can re pack for the trip home.

- Water bottle
- Raincoat (regardless of forecast)
- Hat or cap
- Sleeping bag (extra blanket in winter)
- Pillow
- Sunscreen
- 1 pair pyjamas (tracksuit in cool weather)
- Toiletries (including toothbrush!)
- Insect repellent (roll on only, NO AEROSOLS)
- 1 pair of good walking shoes
- Thongs/Slides – only for going to and from showers
- 2 T-shirts needed, no singlet tank tops / midriff tops (for safety on activities)
- 2 sets of underwear
- 2 pairs of shorts - NO MINI SHORTS
- 2 pairs of track pants
- 2 jumpers / windcheaters
- 2 pairs socks
- Bath towel
- Tissues / hankies
- Plastic bags for dirty clothes / towels.
