LPS will be holding our annual Cross Country races on the Friday of Week 3, Friday 13th May. This is a whole school event, with students from Kindergarten to Year 6 participating. The running course is within LPS and LHS grounds.

All students will need to wear their sport uniform on this day. Students will run in age races for the age they are turning this year. Students who are 8 and 9 will run in separate races, with the first three 9 year olds and the first two 8 year olds selected for the zone Cross Country. (The students are selected this way as the 8/9 year olds run in a combined race in zone and Riverina levels.)
